#### Oct. 12 - Ashdod Port (Jerusalem) Return to Ship

Celebrate the resurrection at the Garden Tomb, have communion and see the Place of the Skull. Walk through the First Century Model of the city of Jerusalem at the Israel Museum. See portions of the Dead Sea Scrolls in the Shrine of the Book. See thousands of years of history in the museum itself. Spend more time in the Old City reflecting on how it would have been in the time of Jesus. Overlook Bethlehem and the rolling hills where shepherds still herd sheep. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.

#### Oct. 13 - Haifa (Galilee)

Visit Caesarea Maritima along the Mediterranean shore, where both Peter and Paul were active in Acts. Journey inland to Galilee and stop at Yardenit to celebrate baptism at the Jordan River. Have lunch at the Decks Restaurant then board a boat to sail on the Sea of Galilee where Jesus calmed the storm. Land at the "Jesus Boat Museum" to see a First Century Galilee boat. Walk the streets of Capernaum, once the headquarters of Jesus' ministry. Overlook the Mount of Beatitudes and recall the words of Christ. Return to the ship for dinner and overnight.
