- Jehoiachin died in Babylon. Jeremiah prophesied that no king from this line would again sit on the throne of David; this ends the line of David through his son Solomon. The Son of David who will sit on the throne through all eternity was born through another line, the line of Nathan (2 Samuel 5:14). Mary was born through that lineage (Luke 3:31); of which Jesus Christ has claim to the

throne of David. The Book of Jeremiah concludes with these important details about the royal line.
