

# **THE POWER OF PRAYER SERIES (Part 1)** *"Seven Keys to Unlock the Power of Prayer!"*

Jeremiah 33:3 - Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

## ~ <u>SEVEN KEYS TO A POWERFUL PRAYER LIFE:</u>

> <u>Key #1</u> – Powerless vs. powerful prayer – Luke 18:9-14 - Powerful prayer is <u>CONTRITE!</u> (The person with a contrite spirit weeps over wrongdoing and expresses genuine

sorrow for his sin (see also Matt 5:4; Luke 6:21; 2 Cor 7:10).)

### > <u>Key #2</u> - Powerful prayer is <u>CONSTANT</u>! - Jesus taught in Matt 7:7-12 (Powerful prayer is constant and active, "ask, seek, knock!")

#### > <u>Key #3</u> - Powerful prayer will transform a <u>NATION</u>! - 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Warren Wiersbe writes, "We are praying to God; prayer is an act of worship, not just an expression of our wants and needs. There should be reverence in our hearts as we pray to God."

- <u>Supplications</u> carries the idea of "offering a request for a felt <u>NEED</u>."

- <u>Intercessions</u> is best translated "petitions." This same word is translated "prayer" in <u>1 Tim 4:5</u>, where it refers to blessing the food we eat. (It is rather obvious that we do not *intercede* for our food in the usual sense of that word.) The basic meaning is "to draw near to a person and converse confidently with him." <u>It suggests that we enjoy fellowship with God so that we have confidence in Him as we pray.</u>

- <u>Giving of thanks</u> is definitely a part of <u>worship</u> and prayer. We not only give thanks for answers to prayer, but for who God is and what He does for us in His grace. We should not simply add our thanksgiving to the end of a selfish prayer! Thanksgiving should be an important ingredient in all of our prayers. In fact, sometimes we need to imitate David and present to God <u>only</u> thanksgiving with no petitions at all! (see <u>Ps 103</u>)

"Prayer and supplication [petition] with thanksgiving" are a part of Paul's formula for <u>God's</u> <u>PEACE in our hearts</u> (<u>Phil 4:6</u>). It is worth noting that Daniel, the great prayer warrior, practiced this kind of praying (<u>Dan 6:10-11</u>)."

### - (v2) We must pray for our <u>GOVERNMENT</u>!

- (v4) Pray that all would come to "the knowledge of the <u>TRUTH</u>!"

- (v5) Jesus Christ is the one and only true <u>MEDIATOR</u> between God and men. (Not Mary, Joseph, the saints, the Pope, a Priest, a Pastor)

- (v8) Men pray <u>EVERYWHERE</u> with holy hands (undefiled from sin).

> <u>Key #4</u> - Power increased through <u>PRAYER and FASTING</u> – Matthew 17:14-21 (Jesus set the example in Matthew 4:1-11 when He overcame the temptations of the devil.)

#### > <u>Key #5</u> – Powerful prayer <u>GLORIFIES</u> the FATHER - Jesus said in John

**14:13-14** - And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be *glorified* in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

> <u>Key #6</u> – Powerful prayer for <u>HEALING</u> – James 5:13-18

(Confess "<u>Private</u> sins" to God and "<u>Public</u> sins" to those offended.)

- Example: Elijah- "a <u>nature</u> like ours"- Hungry- 1 Kings 17:11 Afraid- 1 Kings 19:3 Depressed- 1 Kings19:3, 9-14

- What is the secret to Elijah's powerful prayer life? Elijah "TRUSTED God!"

> Key #7 – Powerful prayer brings JOY – John 16:16-33

## > Make a list of prayer needs for:

YOUR LIFE	CHURCH/MINISTRY	SOULS TO SAVE
